

Why we use the Oil

Treatment Oil keeps the Calm Companion scent directly on your dog and lightly coats and holds down the fur. This may help reduce the static sensation that can add to discomfort during storm conditions. Because the Oil is applied to the coat, no bandana is needed.

A FEW SAFETY BASICS

- Let your dog choose their safest place. Do not force them outside or punish fearful behaviour.
- If storms cause extreme panic, escape attempts or self injury, speak with your veterinarian before storm season.
- Apply the Oil to the coat and avoid the eyes, nose and mouth.
- For dogs only. External use only. Follow the label and stop if irritation occurs.



SCAN FOR PRODUCT USE

Start here

Thunderstorm Anxiety uses the Oil from the very beginning. The first 30 nights build a calm bedtime association. After that, apply it whenever a storm is forecast or even suspected.

WHAT YOU NEED

- Calm Companion Treatment Oil
- A calm bedtime routine for 30 nights
- A comfortable safe place your dog can choose
- Weather alerts so you can apply the Oil early

THE MOST IMPORTANT RULE

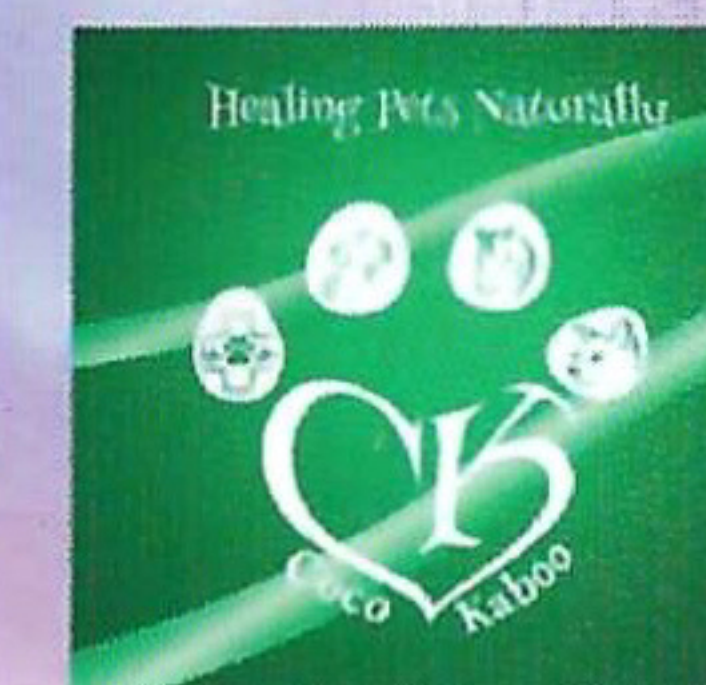
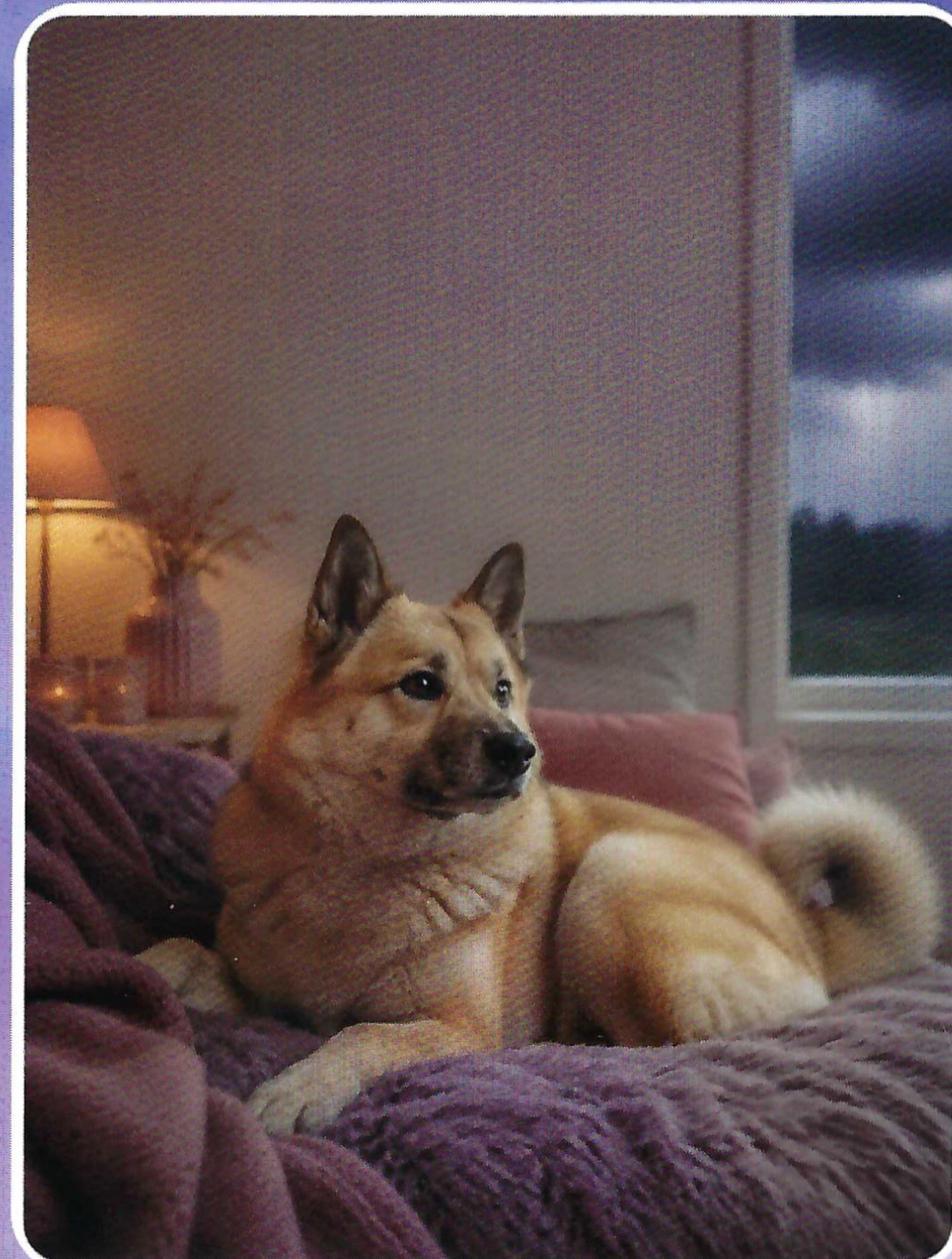
After the first 30 days, apply the Oil whenever you think a storm may develop. It is fine if the storm does not arrive, provided the Oil is used as directed.

Thunderstorm Anxiety

A 30 night scent routine followed by early support whenever a storm may be coming.



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Build the calm link



- 1 Apply immediately before bed**
Use Calm Companion Treatment Oil on the coat, following the label directions, and massage it gently through the fur.
- 2 Keep bedtime quiet**
Go straight into the normal sleep routine. The scent needs to arrive with calm, predictable rest.
- 3 Use it every night**
Consistency matters more than perfect weather. Complete all 30 nights even if no storms occur.
- 4 Keep the first month clear**
During the foundation stage, keep the Oil connected with bedtime so the calm scent association can develop.

A GENTLE CHECKPOINT

After 30 consistent nights, the familiar scent is ready to be used before possible storms.

For the first 30 nights: Oil, calm bedtime and sleep. The same simple pattern every night.

Use it before storms



- 1 Watch for an early warning**
Use a forecast, weather alert or your dog's early behaviour. You do not need to be certain a storm will arrive.
- 2 Apply before anxiety builds**
Put the Oil on the coat as soon as you think a storm may develop. Do not wait for thunder, pacing or trembling.
- 3 A false alarm is fine**
Once the 30 night foundation is complete, apply the Oil whenever a storm is possible. It is fine if the storm does not arrive, provided the Oil is used as directed.
- 4 Keep the message familiar**
Apply it calmly and guide your dog towards the same safe, settled routine used at bedtime.

A GENTLE CHECKPOINT

A forecast or even a suspicion is enough. Applying the Oil early is perfectly fine.

Apply early. The familiar calm scent has time to arrive before the storm does.

Make the world smaller



- 1 Offer a safe place**
Let your dog choose a den, bedroom, covered crate or another familiar place. Keep access open where practical.
- 2 Reduce the outside noise**
Close curtains and windows and use steady background sound, such as a fan, television or calm music.
- 3 Be quietly available**
Stay calm and nearby if your dog seeks you. Comfort does not create fear, but avoid adding frantic energy.
- 4 Use extra help when needed**
Calm Companion can sit alongside veterinary or qualified behaviour support for dogs with severe storm anxiety.

A GENTLE CHECKPOINT

Success may simply mean choosing the safe place, settling sooner or recovering more quickly.

The Oil supports the routine; safety, predictability and calm handling complete the picture.
